Established in 1965, Guru Nanak College Sukhchainana Sahib, Phagwara has been contributing in the field of education, keeping pace with the changing world scenario. We, at GNC, are aware of the fact that a new concept, a new system in education and a new approach towards life is to usher in a generation which will always have the pursuit of excellence as its desired goal. The noble vision of the college informs the whole range of multi-dimensional activities of the college.

GNC is a multi-faculty, Post-Graduate, Co-educational institution offering six Under-Graduate and six Post-Graduate courses in Commerce and Management, Humanities and Arts, Science, Computer Science and IT (Information Technology). The college has also been running Diploma in Computer Maintenance. In order to effectively run such a wide spectrum of courses, the college has an imposing infrastructure consisting of fourteen smart classrooms, well equipped laboratories (Computer Science, Accounting, Languages, and Science) a Centrally Air-Conditioned Well-Stocked Library, Book-Bank, two IT enabled Seminar-Halls, Auditorium, Multi-Purpose Sound Proof Hall, Indoor Courts and Guru Hargobind Sahib Sports Stadium and a shooting range. The academic achievements of our students in various university examinations, this year, are a testimony to the high benchmarks set by the institution in the field of education. In the session 2020-21 our students got 9 distinctions and 7 of them were placed in the merit list.

Besides excellent academic achievements, our students did exceedingly well in co-curricular activities as well though they got limited opportunities due to Covid-19 restrictions. Students participated in various inter-college competitions like slogan writing, classical vocal poster-making, essay-writing, patriotic competitions and brought laurels to the college by securing positions.

In the field of sports, the institution has carved a niche for itself. Our students have shown brilliant performance in inter-college, inter-

versity, State and National level tournaments. Our college football team, bagged Runner up trophy in Punjab Youth League (Under-21) Football Tournament organized by Punjab Football Association. It is a matter of pride for the institution that our student player Tarun Slathia was declared as best scorer in this tournament.

To channelize the multi-dimensional facets of students' personality, various clubs and societies like N.C.C., N.S.S., Guru Gobind Singh Study Circle, Red Ribbon Club, Youth Welfare Club and different subject societies/Associations remain vibrant by organizing different completions, extension lectures, awareness campaigns and induction programs. This year students of N.C.C. took BEE and CEE Certificate exams and were awarded ranks. The college hosted Annual Training Camp under the able leadership of Lt. Ashutosh Attri. N.S.S. unit of the college organized tree plantation programs, quiz and World Environment Day and UNO Day etc. Red Ribbon Club took the students to nearby villages for Covid Awareness Campaign and distributed masks, soaps and sanitizer bottles by going door to door. This year the college organized limited activities due to suspension of physical classes. Some of the activities were organized via online mode.

Staying abreast with the contemporary competitive job scenario, our Career Counseling Cell makes earnest efforts to provide latest information to aspiring candidates about latest career venues. This year our student Angad Gurdev Singh got placed in manager grade in IDFC First Bank, Loveleen Tandon of M.Com. got placed as Assistant Manager in AM Grade in Statutory Audit Department of Audit and Assurance function at Deloitte Haskins & Sells LLP and Pankaj Jain in AM grade. Three of our students Harpreet Singh, Maninder Singh of B.A. and Sarbjit Singh of M.A. (Punjabi) got placements in reputed organizations.

The college rigorously strives to redress the grievances of all the stakeholders. Special attention is given to the problems of needy and deserving students by providing free books and grants in the form of fee-concessions and scholarships. This year college added another feather in

its cap by granting 15,41,966/- as scholarship to the meritorious students. Out of this, 27 meritorious students were given scholarship of 1,05,511/- under Bhai Rupinder Singh Rupri Trust Scheme. Outstanding players were also given fee concession of rupees 1,26,550/-. Liberal fee concession was provided to the students in covid time. We are thankful to our Alumni and Philanthropists who run Trusts and Foundations for the above said purpose.

The college also keeps organizing a number of seminars and workshops for up-gradation of existing knowledge base of its teaching and non-teaching faculty. This year the college arranged a training program “Online Data Storage & Management” for all the staff members. Following the pattern of previous years, the college got an Academic and Green Audit conducted from eminent academicians.
